

## JANUARY FEBRUARY

Complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the 2025–2026 school year. **Please note that the US Department of Education (DOE) uses “prior, prior base year” (PPY) data collection. This means that applicants should complete the FAFSA using 2023 income information.**

The FAFSA may be submitted online at [studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa](https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa). The NBSS school code is: **015527**. In order to complete the FAFSA, you (and your parents if you are under the age of 24) will need to create an FSA ID, or use an existing FSA ID, to complete the FAFSA.

For September enrollment, the Financial Aid Office encourages all students to submit their FAFSA by February 15. Early application allows for plenty of time to implement a solid financial plan for the upcoming school year.

NBSS Scholarship consideration is automatic once you have completed the FAFSA. This includes NBSS Institutional Scholarships, NBSS Pell Yes!, NBSS Workforce, and NBSS Yellow Ribbon.
